

Career Education Convention COVID-19 guidelines for on-site attendees

The CECU team is making every effort to host the CEO Summit safely in person this year. We request that all individuals attending the conference in-person review and follow the procedures outlined below to ensure a safe and comfortable experience for all. These guidelines apply to all onsite attendees notwithstanding more lenient standards that might apply in the attendee's home state. Consistent with government recommendations, we encourage all attendees to be vaccinated prior to attending the convention.

Career Education Convention COVID-19 guidelines for on-site attendees*:

- Attendees will be asked for proof of vaccination prior to entering the meeting area.
- Without proof of vaccination, masks must be worn in all meeting spaces and CECU sanctioned events.
- Registrants who have experienced the following symptoms within 10 days prior to the event will not be permitted to attend in-person. We will accommodate any last-minute changes or cancelations that are COVID-19 related. Please contact the CECU staff if you have any of the following symptoms within 10 days after the event.
 - o Fever or chills
 - o Cough
 - o Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - o Fatigue
 - o Muscle or body aches
 - o Headache
 - o Recent loss of taste or smell
 - o Sore throat
 - o Congestion
 - o Nausea or vomiting
 - o Diarrhea
 - o Tested positive for COVID-19
 - o Been in close contact with anyone who tested positive for COVID-19
